The Trial Process

Trial Process

- All players must arrive 30 minutes prior to the scheduled trial time and bring their boots, shin pads, water bottle and a positive attitude.
- Trials will be organised by the EWFC Head Coach and Development Committee. Independent Selectors will assist in the assessments.
- No Selector or Coach shall undertake an active role in the assessment of their own child during the trials.
- The trials will be held by age group and may include two sessions.
- Players must trial in their correct age group to be assessed with their peers. A further session(s) may be required - players will be notified if required to attend a further session/s.
- Players who are unable to attend Grading Sessions may be considered based on their playing history with EWFC, however, priority will be given to players who attend all grading sessions.
- The evaluation process is based on selected drills, small sided games and a standard game based on the age group.
- At the conclusion of the trial, the selectors shall review and discuss the assessments of each player and begin the process of allocating players to a team. The selectors' assessments and team recommendations will then be provided to the Development Committee for final consideration prior to offers being made.
- Offers to play in Division 1 (or if applicable the Division 2) team will be made via email. Those players not invited will be directed to the appropriate Age Coordinator to be allocated into a team. If you are offered a position you must reply by email by the deadline given to accept.
- Players may appeal a Development Committee decision by writing to their Age Coordinator with their objection and supporting information to substantiate their claim. The appropriate Development Committee will assess the claim and deliver its decision to the player and/or parent within 10 days. The Committee's decision is final.
